Within the framework of the contractual or pre-contractual relationship, we process identification data, professional contact details and financial data necessary to manage orders, invoice and comply with legal obligations.

When processing is based on your consent, you may withdraw it at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on your prior consent.

Recipients of the Data

BC Motors will not disclose your data to third parties, except in the following cases:

- Legal obligation: when communication is required by the competent tax, judicial or administrative authorities.
- **Service providers (processors): companies that provide web hosting, IT maintenance, accounting or logistics services, with whom we have entered into the corresponding data processing contract (art. 28 GDPR) ensuring confidentiality and data security.**

No international data transfers outside the European Economic Area (EEA) are carried out. If any provider is located outside the EEA, appropriate safeguards provided in Chapter V of the GDPR will be adopted (Standard Contractual Clauses or European Commission adequacy decisions).

Your Rights

Obtaining confirmation whether we process your data and access it.

⇌ Rectification

Correct inaccurate or incomplete data.

☐ Deletion

Request deletion of your data when it is no longer necessary.

☐ **Limitation**

Request suspension of processing in certain circumstances.

☐ **Portability**

Receive your data in a structured and commonly used format.

☐ **Objection**

Object to processing based on legitimate interest or direct marketing.

☐ **Automated decisions**

Not be subject to decisions based solely on automated processing.

☐ **Revocation**

Revoke consent at any time.
